

Class of 2012 graduate, Anthony (Tony) Tran, recently returned from a summer program in Vietnam where he was able to immerse himself in the work of continuing education of mind, body, and spirit.



"The program is designed to expose Vietnamese to the English language from native speakers, and help them grow in their English confidence. I chose to partake in this program because I was challenged during a recent talk where the speaker charged us with finding something we could do to **help the world!**

In June, I taught English to Jesuits who had just come out of the Novitiate, working on creative writing skills and poetry. I taught with three other teachers, two of whom were actually American Jesuits. We lived on the compound and lived their lifestyle. I took this as an opportunity to learn more about Jesuit lifestyle and kept an open heart to see if this might be a life I want to follow. Since the program ended, I find myself open to the Jesuit calling. I will continue to learn and reflect on this experience to improve myself and **discover God's will**.

In July, we met up with five more instructors and took on a class of 70 students in the Cathedral in Binh Duong to teach Reading Comprehension. This was a **joyous time** for me and brought about a growth in confidence and interest in a possible career in teaching.

My time there was incredible. I was able to learn so much about my culture and was able to begin to figure out the Vietnamese part of my Vietnamese-American identity. I learned about the hospitality and the joy that the Vietnamese people have with life. I learned about the corruption and effects of communism that drove my parents to run away from the country during the war. I hope to continue work like this, to find out more about myself, and to **help people** around the world. Growing my knowledge and learning how to be present with people is a great experience!"

How long have you been teaching at Arrupe Jesuit?

A bit over a year.

What brought you to Arrupe Jesuit?

I graduated from Arrupe Jesuit in 2011 and received my Bachelor's at Regis University in 2015. I double majored in Spanish and Sociology with a minor in Criminology. After, I was part of the Alum Service Corp at Regis Jesuit High



School. I really enjoyed teaching Spanish and teaching others about my language, culture, and traditions. When my ASC year was about to end I had to make a tough decision: to accept a job at Arrupe or accept a position in a volunteer program in Spain. I decided to return to Arrupe.

I remember growing up wanting to know more about my history and culture. At Arrupe, I am able to offer that opportunity to my students. I want my students to understand better their culture and learn more about it. In class, we start off the year learning about their own culture then comparing it to the Spanish culture, in order for them to see and value who they are.

Arrupe Jesuit is special because of the community that is formed throughout the four years of high school. I am still best friends with my Arrupe friends because of all the moments we shared during retreats and in the classroom.

As a faculty member, it is evident how much teachers care about their students' success and are willing to dedicate time to meet students where they are. I remember, as a student, when I had trouble in my Social Studies class, the teacher stayed after school with students to help us. It was a challenging class that I was grateful for because it helped me feel comfortable asking for help.

What is one of your most memorable experiences here?

Last year, students were acting out a scene of Don Quixote; I enjoyed experiencing the energy they had while performing!

What is your hope for our students/alumni?

I hope students don't forget the Jesuit values and go on to live a life of social justice. I hope they each find something they are passionate about.






