- Create weekly mini-lessons to foster student professional growth
- Design monthly supervisor training sessions to support them in their roles
- Develop and implement training programs for students removed from jobs due to performance issues

- Manage relationships with approximately 25 business partners, facilitating communication and addressing issues with student workers and supervisors
- Conduct bi-annual site visits to assess student progress and enhance program effectiveness
- Collaborate with supervisors to establish successful student work programs
- Monitor student timecards and address issues proactively
- Ensure companies understand their role in student formation and Arrupe's mission

Logistical Support:
