Position Description

Arrupe Jesuit High School is seeking a candidate to head its girls' volleyball program.

Qualifications

Some experience coaching at the high school level is expected. Ability to coordinate schedules and manage personnel is a must. Strong strategic planning within a flexible framework is a significant plus.

School Context

Arrupe Jesuit High School is a co-educational, college preparatory, Catholic Jesuit school serving economically disadvantaged, racially and culturally diverse youth in Denver. Arrupe Jesuit follows the rich tradition of Ignatian education and its fulfillment of the Graduate at Graduation. In addition, Arrupe Jesuit utilizes the Corporate Work Study model of the Cristo Rey Network whereby its students earn a majority of their tuition by working in a corporate setting five days each month during the school year.

The volleyball program, consisting of four levels, competes at the 3A classification in the Frontier League. A two-time state qualifier with strong participant numbers, the varsity team is in need of a reboot and a long-term placement at the head coaching position.

Coaching candidates will be able to...

Oversee a year-round program

- This includes: schedule practices, weight training, and competition to build the skills of all participants.
- The school has support for an in-house club program that competes in RMR tournaments. In past years, there have been three levels.
- Cultivate an environment based in values that are aligned with the school's mandate and mission.

Teach the game at differentiated levels

- While a significant number of players will be returning, some will be beginner players. They will need basic training in passing, rotation, etc.
- The varsity level players require technical server and setting instruction, in addition to strategic and match specific planning.

Coordinate many components/personnel

- The CWSP component of the school directly affects athletics on a daily basis. Practices and matches will sometimes begin short an athlete.
- Four levels of competition will require a full staff of around 3-5 people. The school will be able to provide some of this support. Candidates should be able to hire other personnel.
