Arrupe Jesuit High School is a Roman Catholic, co-educational, college preparatory school sponsored by the Jesuits of the USA Central and Southern Province. Arrupe Jesuit serves economically disadvantaged students from Denver's inner-city neighborhoods. By enhancing the human, intellectual, and spiritual capacities of our students through a rigorous, innovative, and affordable college preparatory education, we offer hope for a brighter future to some of Denver's neediest youth. Our goal is to empower graduates who will continue their education and return as leaders in their communities.

Arrupe Jesuit is accredited by Cognia(formerly AdvancED) and is a member of the Jesuit Schools Network (JSN) and the Cristo Rey Network(CRN).

- ◇ 78% of Arrupe Jesuit families participate in the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program
- ◇ Average income for a family of four is \$44,480
- ◇ 100% of Arrupe Jesuit students receive financial aid towards stated tuition
- ◇ Overall, 69% of graduating seniors are the first in their families to graduate from high school
- ◇ Overall, 89% of graduates are the first in their families to go on to college



CORPORATE WORK STUDY PROGRAM (CWSP)

- ◇ Over 100 partner organizations, including 6 companies who have been with us since our founding as well as 18 new companies.
- ◇ Students participate in job sharing full-time, entry level jobs by working 5 days per month.
- ◇ Students will earn over \$2 million through their CWSP jobs in the 2021-2022 school year, which is nearly 50% of the cost of their college preparatory education.
- ◇ Students are employees of CWSP. Arrupe Jesuit's staff handles all payroll, W-4, I-9, workers' compensation and other employer services for students.
- ◇ Arrupe Jesuit trains the students, provides transportation to and from their job site, and works with partner organizations to assign motivated, enthusiastic student workers who can best meet an organization's business needs.

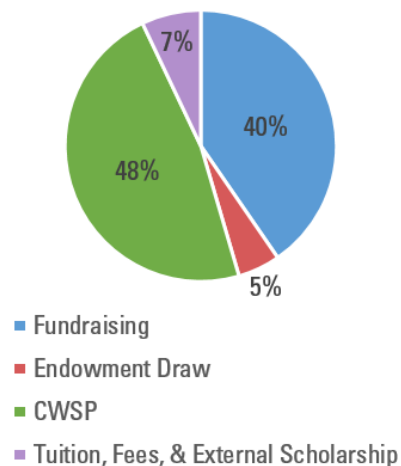


ARRUPE JESUIT'S UNIQUE MODEL

ARRUPE JESUIT HIGHLIGHTS & RESULTS

- ◇ 100% of Arrupe Jesuit's first fifteen graduating classes were accepted into at least one college or university of their choice, with the most recent Class of 2021 earning more than \$17 million in merit & community based scholarships.
- ◇ 1,073 alumni who together have earned over \$103.7 million in scholarship dollars.
- ◇ \$27.1 Million Earned from Corporate Work Study Jobs through June 2021
- ◇ 62% College Persistence as of May 2021 (defined as either currently enrolled in college courses or have earned degree or certificate), a rate three times that of their demographic peers.
